Pinewoods Ashbourne Respite Service provides overnight breaks to children from age 8 to 19 years old (provided they are in full-time education).

We provide specialist support for a mixed group of children with intellectual disabilities and/or autism spectrum conditions, associated social and communication difficulties and behaviours of concern.

Many of the children attending Pinewoods will be allocated 1:1 or 2:1 staffing based on their individual needs.
